





Designed by award-winning architect Tan Hock Beng, Princess d'Ân Nam's majestic architecture is a blend of modernist sensibility and post-French colonial ambience, infused with Oriental imagery.

Surrounded by tropical gardens, the 57 sumptuous accommodation villas are designed to provide guests with privacy and an intimate sanctuary within a sanctuary.

Thirty-six Mandarin Suites overlook two pools from private verandas and within, feature an extravagant bathing and grooming area. With a King-size four-poster bed and outdoor bathtub and plunge pool enclosed by walls, the 18 Princess Villas are perfect for honeymooners and couples seeking precious time alone. Each treatment is tailor-made to individual requirements, while multi-hour Spa Packages cater for those with more time for heavenly indulgences.

The palatial 1,800sqm temple of wellness stands on the beach opposite the stately lighthouse and dazzling South China Sea - visible through the vast glass frontage. Enter a sublime oasis of calm, where senses are aroused by beauty, fragrance and soothing therapies.

Set around a Moroccan-style inner courtyard with mysterious alcoves, ten treatment rooms are divided into separate male and female sections, ensuring utmost privacy for guests.

Couples can immerse themselves in treatments a deux in two VIP suites, where a glass of champagne enjoyed in the Jacuzzi and overnight stays add-up to precious moments of romance.

The sunken outdoor Jacuzzi on the beachfront deck is another spa delight that should not be missed.







HISTORIC LIGHTHOUSE

On a rocky island opposite Princess d'Ân Nam stands Ke Ga Lighthouse: French-built in 1899, the oldest operating - and tallest - lighthouse in Vietnam. With a local guide, take a traditional basket boat over to the lighthouse. Climb to the top for marvelous bay views and enjoy a refreshing swim off the island.

KE GA BAY ON TWO WHEELS

The countryside surrounding Princess d'Ân Nam introduces a traditional Vietnamese way of life. Take a cycling tour through outlying Ke Ga Bay, where you are soon transported to sweeping rice fields, dragon fruit orchards and salt farms surrounding peaceful villages. Bicycles - including children's sizes - are available for rental.

NATURE BY RUSSIAN JEEPS

Touring by the resort's own Russian jeeps is an exciting way to experience the region's stunning natural attractions and mountainous terrain. Armed with picnics and sense of adventure, explore landscapes of rainforests, tropical flora and fauna and surreal, towering sand dunes by four-wheel drive.

GOLF

Phan Thiet is home to one of Southeast Asia's most acclaimed courses, Ocean Dunes Golf Club. Designed by Nick Faldo and a "Finest Golf Clubs of the World" member, the par 72, 18-hole links course delivers challenging holes and impressive sea views. Sprawling across the sand dunes of Cape Mui Ne, relatively new Sea Links Golf and Country Club already ranks as one of Vietnam's most striking and challenging courses. Both clubs are less than an hour's drive away.



PHAN THIET

Founded 1933 by the French Governor of Indochina, Phan Thiet today is still essentially a traditional fishing port. The brightly coloured fishing trawlers and bustling fish markets at the harbour are a photographer's dream. Leisurely explore other city sights by pedicab.

PO SHA NU TOWER

Perched on a hill and markedly visible for miles, three Cham towers date back to the eighth century - architectural remains of the ancient and mystical Champa Kingdom that once dominated the region for hundreds of years.


TA CU NATURE RESERVE

Take a short hike or cable car ride through rainforests teeming with exotic birdlife to the top of Ta Cu Mountain. The peak is home to a pagoda and largest reclining Buddha in Southeast Asia. From here, you can appreciate panoramic views of the distant mountains and coastline.

CAPE MUI NE

Within an impressive arc of golden sands stretching 16km, Cape Mui Ne has long been a strong fishing community. Nowadays, it's also Vietnam's fastest growing beach resort destination and premier kite and windsurfing hub. Mui Ne is also famed for its spectacular Red Dunes, White Dunes and Lotus Lake, plus Fairy Springs - a picturesque stream flanked by red canyons.
