Upstream 1 — 5 Days/4 Nights — Every Wednesday Ho Chi Minh City to Phnom Penh

- DAY 1: Ho Chi Minh City Cai Be Can Tho Tiger Island (62km, 4hrs cruising)

 Transfer by road to Hoang Dieu Port in Can Tho with en-route lunch stop at Le Longanier Restaurant in Cai Be. Board Victoria

 Mekong in Can Tho Sail on to Tiger Island. Anchor for the night on the river between Long Xuyen and Tiger Island. "Don Ca
 - Mekong in Can Tho. Sail on to Tiger Island. Anchor for the night on the river between Long Xuyen and Tiger Island. "Don Ca Tai Tu" traditional music performance on board.
- DAY 2: Long Xuyen Tiger Island Vam Nao (32km, 2hrs cruising)
 In the morning discover the Floating market in Long Xuyen and visit the An Giang Museum, full of artifacts about the ethnies populating the region. In the afternoon sail to Tiger Island to visit the tiger Temple and experience other local crafts. Visit is done by sampan and "xe loi". Continue sailing towards Vam Nao where the ship anchors for the night.
- DAY 3: Vam Nao Tan Chau (32km, 2hrs cruising)

 Early morning the ship sails to Tan Chau where you will visit a unique Silk Village where silk is produced following traditional techniques, using only natural dyes. In the afternoon, visit some fish farms and a colourful Taoist Temple, with Fortune Tellers eager to tell you your fortune. Optional excursion to Tra Su Bird Sanctuary near Chau Doc. Lion Dance performance on board.
- DAY 4: Tan Chau Phnom Penh (110km, 8hrs cruising)
 The ship set sails towards Phnom Penh, passing the Vietnam-Cambodia border. A full day of cruising with activities on board.
 Arrival in Phnom Penh late afternoon. Apsara dance performance on board. Overnight in Phnom Penh
- Day 5: Phnom Penh
 Breakfast is served on board. Passengers disembark at Sisowath Quay.

Upstream 2 — 5 Days/4 Nights — Every Wednesday Can Tho Harbour to Phnom Penh

DAY 1: Can Tho – Tiger Island (62km, 4hrs cruising)

Board Victoria Mekong in Can Tho. Sail on to Tiger Island. Anchor for the night on the river between Long Xuyen and Tiger Island. "Don Ca Tai Tu" traditional music performance on board.

• DAY 2: Long Xuyen - Tiger Island - Vam Nao (32km, 2hrs cruising)

In the morning discover the Floating market in Long Xuyen and visit the An Giang Museum, full of artifacts about the ethnies populating the region. In the afternoon sail to Tiger Island to visit the tiger Temple and experience other local crafts. Visit is done partly by "xe loi". Continue sailing towards Vam Nao where the ship anchors for the night.

DAY 3: Vam Nao - Tan Chau (32km, 2hrs cruising)

Early morning the ship sails to Tan Chau where you will visit a unique Silk Village where silk is produced following traditional techniques, using only natural dyes. In the afternoon, visit some fish farms and a colourful Taoist Temple, with Fortune Tellers eager to tell you your fortune. Optional excursion to Tra Su Bird Sanctuary near Chau Doc. Lion Dance performance on board.

• DAY 4: Tan Chau - Phnom Penh (110km, 8hrs cruising)

The ship set sails towards Phnom Penh, passing the Vietnam-Cambodia border. A full day of cruising with activities on board. Arrival in Phnom Penh late afternoon. Apsara dance performance on board. Overnight in Phnom Penh

Day 5: Phnom Penh

Breakfast is served on board. Passengers disembark at Sisowath Quay.

NOTE: Transfer between Ho Chi Minh City and Can Tho is not included in this itinerary.

Downstream 1 — 4 Days/3 Nights — Every Sunday Phnom Penh to Ho Chi Minh City

- DAY 1: Phnom Penh
 Board Victoria Mekong in Phnom Penh. Apsara performance on board. Night on board.
- DAY 2: Phnom Penh Vam Nao (133km, 7.5hrs cruising)
 Cross the Border into Vietnam. In the afternoon, arrive in Vam Nao where you will anchor for the night and get onshore to visit some traditional activities such as claypot fabrication and traditional rice cakes. In the evening, Lion Dance performance on board.
- DAY 3: Vam Nao Long Xuyen Tan Loc Island (80km, 4hrs cruising) / Tan Loc Can Tho (46km, 2 hours cruising)
 Stop in Long Xuyen to visit the Floating market and the An Giang Museum, full of artifacts about the ethnies populating the region. Set sail again towards Tan Loc Island to visit a Plum wine Distillery and an ancient house where tea will be served.
 The ship will then resume sailing to Can Tho and dock for the night in the river.
- DAY 4: Can Tho Cai Be Ho Chi Minh City
 Early morning visit the renowned Cai Rang Floating Market by sampan. Breakfast will be served on board the Victoria
 Mekong after your visit, while sailing to Hoang Dieu Port for your last stop. Disembark and transfer by road to Ho Chi Minh
 City with en-route stop at Le Longanier Restaurant in Cai Be.

Downstream 2 — 4 Days/3 Nights — Every Sunday Phnom Penh to Can The Harbour

DAY 1: Phnom Penh

Board Victoria Mekong in Phnom Penh. Apsara performance on board. Night on board.

DAY 2: Phnom Penh – Vam Nao (133km, 7.5hrs cruising)

Cross the Border into Vietnam. In the afternoon, arrive in Vam Nao where you will anchor for the night and get onshore to visit some traditional activities such as claypot fabrication and traditional rice cakes. In the evening, Lion Dance performance on board.

• DAY 3: Vam Nao – Long Xuyen – Tan Loc Island (80km, 4hrs cruising) / Tan Loc – Can Tho (46km, 2 hours cruising)

Stop in Long Xuyen to visit the Floating market and the An Giang Museum, full of artifacts about the ethnies populating the region. Set sail again towards Tan Loc Island to visit a Plum wine Distillery and an ancient house where tea will be served.

The ship will then resume sailing to Can Tho and dock for the night in the river.

DAY 4: Can Tho

Early morning visit the renowned Cai Rang Floating Market by sampan. Breakfast will be served on board the Victoria Mekong after your visit

NOTE: Passengers can transfer to Ho Chi Minh City or catch direct flight to Hanoi, Danang or Phu Quoc, as arranged by Tour Operator. No transfer is included in this itinerary.
